

DECONSTRUCTION / SALVAGE - DOORS

Concept – Doors can be reused in many fashions, including as furniture (table-tops) and second lives as doors.

Attention – Framing Subcontractors
Deconstruction Crews, Materials Specialists

Action –

- Gently and partially pry up door trim using a flat bar and pull the nails as you go along.
- Stack casing alternating face-to-face and back-to-back to protect them for reuse.
- Pry the door jamb away from the framing, starting in the middle of one side in order to expose the nail shaft.
- Cut exposed nails using a Sawzall. Use the Sawzall to check for intact nails by running it between the jamb and the framing.
- Remove the door and the jamb and secure the doors shut by screwing through the jamb into the door about 1-2 feet off the ground.



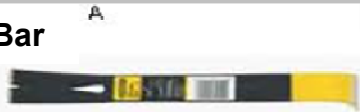
